Petition to GVRD: Install Lighting at Glen Cove Park to Enhance Safety and Usability

To the Greater Vallejo Recreation District (GVRD):

We, the pickleball players and other users of Glen Cove Park in Vallejo, respectfully request the installation of lighting at Glen Cove Park. As one of the most vibrant and utilized recreational spaces in the city, Glen Cove Park serves not only as a hub for pickleball but also as a cherished community space for families, neighbors, and residents of all ages.

During the shorter days of fall and winter, darkness falls as early as 4:30 PM, limiting the park's usability and leaving the area dimly lit and underutilized. Installing lights at Glen Cove Park would significantly enhance safety, maximize the park's potential, and provide extended opportunities for residents to enjoy its courts and other facilities.

Key Benefits of Lighting at Glen Cove Park:

By extending the hours of use, lighting would support the physical and mental well-being of park visitors. Pickleball players and other users would have more opportunities to engage in healthy activities, while families could safely enjoy the playground and courts even after dark.

Extending the hours of safe activity at the park would reduce the number of dark, idle hours that can lead to unsafe or undesirable situations.
